If your child already attend nursery on a Tuesday morning, they will automatically have their photos taken, but if they don't and you would like them to have a photo or would like them to have their photo with a sibling who doesn't attend, then please pop an email to the office and we will give you a time slot.

FUNDING - We have now sent out emails to those parents who will be able to apply for funding for their 2 year olds, to receive it from April 2024. Please do this as soon as possible, and let us know as soon as you have received your code.

We are aware that some of you are waiting for a letter with a temporary code, again, as soon as you have received this letter/code, please let us know.

We have various forms for you to sign here at nursery, so please have your unique code (when received), and the national insurance number of the parent claiming ready.

30 Hours Childcare - If your child is eligible for the '30 hours' funding from April now that they are 3, we will again have some forms for you to sign, so please have your unique code, and the national insurance number of the parent claiming ready.

Please can we remind you to reapply every 3 months. If there are changes to your entitlement, or you do not reconfirm please let us know as this could impact your invoice!

All About Me - We will be sending out an 'All About Me' on Tapestry for you to complete so that we can learn more about your child's interests, likes, dislikes, needs etc. We use the information to ensure we are meeting the individual needs of your child while they are with us, they really are valuable to the staff team when planning our activities. They are also a great way to update us if anything has changed!

Reports - We have now sent across the Winter reports across to Tapestry. These are not a lengthy report like you would get at school but a shorter feedback from your keyperson to let you know how your little one is doing at nursery. If you have any questions please get back to your keyperson or contact Sophie/Jordyn in the office, we are always be happy to help.

If you are thinking of toilet training your little one, please have a chat with one of the ladies and we will always be happy to support you with this.

Tooth Brushing - Tooth decay remains very common in young children. Tooth decay can be very painful, cause problems eating/sleeping and stop children attending early years settings. There is a requirement within the Early Years Foundation Stage to promote good oral health to children and supervised toothbrushing programmes are an effective way to do this. To make sure more children get to benefit from taking part in supervised toothbrushing programmes a new website has been developed, as part of a national research project, to include resources needed by all those involved in getting toothbrushing programmes set-up and running well. Late collection – just a reminder that we charge a £15 late fee for every 15 minutes that you are late collecting your child. If you do collect just before 6pm you will only get a brief feedback as staff leave at 6pm – Thank you for your support with this.

Clothing - Please remember your little one will get messy at nursery, we love to embrace messy play and engage the senses! It would be best to bring them to nursery in old clothing (including coats) so that they can enjoy themselves in the mud kitchen, painting, gloop etc

Arriving at Abacus - Please do ring the doorbell (even if you think you have been spotted by staff as we have one lady assigned to the door and they might not know you are here!) and remember you can wait in the porch! If the door is not answered within a minute please do

ring again. If you arrive and another parent is in front of you it might be wise to check they have rung the bell just in case they haven't \bigcirc

Medical Care Plans/Allergies - We have recently sent home new medical care plans for children with intolerances and allergies to check that our records are up to date, could we ask that they are returned within the 28 days as per County guidance. If anything changes please update us so that we can change paperwork and ensure we are fully meeting the needs of your child. We now have 16 children (almost a quarter of our children) with allergies/intolerances which is the highest number ever so we would appreciate your support with this as it does restrict our menu.

Transitions - We of course have children transitioning to primary school later in the year. We know that any transition can be viewed as a difficult time but we know from experience that by working together to ensure your child is ready for their transition, with a consistent and positive approach it can be a happy time for everyone. A factsheet will be added to Tapestry soon so please look out for this and get back to us if you have any further questions. We also have a school transition meeting (parents only) for those of you who would like to chat further about this. If you will be attending the meeting on April 8th please email the office to confirm before the end of March - Thank you

September onwards - We are almost full every day so if you wanted to increase please let us know as soon as possible! If your little one will be moving onto funding in September you might want extra sessions it would be a good idea to try and book the sessions now or you might be disappointed! Some days are already full.

Book Swap - please take advantage of our book swap in the porch, many children do use it and enjoy having something new to read © Reading stories to your little one provides an exciting way into worlds children could not otherwise visit and helps to develop their imagination. Looking at books also supports rich language development and helps to develop your child's brain!

Coat swap - If you have a good/clean child's coat that you would like to pass on please pop it on the pegs just inside of the porch so that another parent can take it home and use for their little one! With children's winter coats costing £25-30 (on average) we feel this is a good saving, and little ones outgrow clothing so quickly! \bigcirc
