## Dear Parents/Carers,

Key person - Please remember that all staff care and nurture for all children on each floor and all staff are familiar with all children in the nursery due to how we run our days so if your child has a change in key person please do not worry. Apart from the parent chats and Tapestry updates you should not be aware of any change and of course the children are not even aware who their key person is so there will be no change to the high level of care they receive.

**Pupil Premium** - If your child receives 15/30 hour funding you might be eligible to apply for Pupil Premium, please look at the link below. The forms only take a few minutes to complete and the nursery would be given the payments directly. Any money claimed through pupil premium would go directly to supporting your child's nursery experience and needs. <u>Early Years pupil premium information for parents (somerset.gov.uk)</u>

**Tapestry** - Please remember to save any photos/posts you like on Tapestry as your child's account closes when they leave. We would recommend saving things throughout their time with us rather than waiting until they leave as this could be a lengthy process!

New Menu/Food - Our Summer Menu, this will start on April  $1^{st}$ . The menu is now on our Website for you to see so please take a look  $\bigcirc$  We are looking forward to having Summer casserole with couscous, Gazpacho and Lemon broccoli pasta! Our menu is planned to meet all the nutritional needs of your little ones and it is delicious.

Just a little reminder that we are a nut free setting so if buying a birthday cake please ensure it contains no nuts, and that for babies/toddlers upstairs no chocolate!

Clothing for all weather! - With the weather warming up a little on some days please remember to pack suitable clothing, it's that tricky time of year where its warm one day and really cold the next! We appreciate your support with this.

Sickness - If contacted because your little one is poorly we ask that you collect them (or arrange for someone else to collect them) within 30 minutes. We have had several times recently where it has taken parents a lot longer to arrive, (an hour/hour and a half) and although we understand that on occasions you might be slightly over the 30 minutes we do ask that you try to and adhere to this. We appreciate that some of you work away but we do ask that an emergency contact is also added to paperwork to help with this type of situation. Once a child is sick they isolate with a staff member until collected which impacts the rest of the nursery, and sometimes the longer a little one waits the more anxious/unwell they become. Can we also add that if your child needs regular Calpol to help them feel well enough for nursery then they really should be at home resting. Although we can give lots of cuddles, nursery is a much busier environment and when your little one is under the weather this can be overwhelming - Thank you for your anticipated support.

Tax Fee Childcare - Please follow the link to see if you are eligible for Tax Free Childcare. Funding- Please can we remind you to reconfirm your funding eligibility codes every 3 months to continue to have eligibility for this funding. If your circumstances change and you are no longer eligible please make sure you let us know so that we can make the necessary changes to invoices/paperwork. If any child starting their 15/30 hours this year would like to increase their hours we do only have a few odd sessions left until September 2025! If you forget to reconfirm and your funding runs out this could impact your invoice and full fees may need to be paid so please let us know.

Invoices - Please remember to review your standing order for April fees as this is a new term and to check you are paying into the new Abacus bank account! You should receive your new invoice soon (hopefully next week). Your support in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Fees - This year, due to rises in wages (minimum wage) and utility bills we are having to make a rise in line with inflation and the cost of living this year. This increase will help us to maintain our outstanding provision. Please see below for Fees from April 1<sup>st</sup> 2024 -

Hair Bands - Could we ask that you do not to use the tiny hair rubber bands (also known as mini elastics) at nursery as they can be a choking hazard for our younger children and babies. Children do quite often take their hair out/down during the day and then we find bands on the floor! Normal hairbands are fine as quite visual but the tiny elastics can get missed and are then dangerous. We would also ask that you try not to use bobbles with beads on as again if they break this can be a choking hazard. Thank You
